

Dear Student,

Everyone at Hanover College hopes you and your family are safe and healthy during this unprecedented time. The impact of the Coronavirus on virtually every aspect of our lives is difficult to fathom. In response, the U.S. government passed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The CARES Act provides funding to colleges, and the colleges in turn must use a portion of the funding to provide resources to students who have been negatively affected financially by the Coronavirus.

As a FAFSA filer, you may be eligible to receive funds if you incurred unexpected expenses related to the disruption of campus operations because of the Coronavirus.

Once submitted, please allow up to 30 days to be notified if you are eligible to receive funds, and what the amount will be. Please note eligibility depends on a number of factors and there is no guarantee you will receive funds. You should consult with a tax advisor to determine whether any funds you receive may constitute taxable income.

Dear Student,

To provide additional assistance to our students with Federal Pell Grants, Hanover College is distributing emergency financial aid from CARES Act funding to these students.
